I. Injury Summary:

Date Of Injury:	January 18, 2010
Date Reported:	January 22, 2010
Injury Type:	Left Shin puncture wound
Injury Cause:	Employee opened door and walked into protruding sharp edge of a cart.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	The accident investigation revealed someone had left a rolling cart just outside of a door making a trip and fall hazard. There is now a policy in place keeping carts in a designated area. The investigation also revealed the injured worker was walking far to fast to stop in time to prevent accident All employees will be trained on safe walking and paying attention.
