<b>Injury Cause:</b>	Stuck by large plant stand in front of building. Sustained injuries to the head, shoulder, arm, hip, calf and fractured ankle.
<b>Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:</b>	The accident investigation revealed a passenger car jumped a curb hitting a concrete pillar which fell over onto and knocking over the large plant stand onto employee. Even though this type of chain reaction accident could be considered an act of God, there are some things that could be done to prevent it from happening again. Such as barriers or the plant stand placed out of the parking lot area, etc. We can always find an answer to any situation by simply using the accident investigation to drill down and uncover what truly has occurred.
