Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. I. Injury Summary:

Date Of Injury:	4-26-08
Date Reported:	4-26-08
Injury Type:	Bite to right arm and right leg
Injury Cause:	An employee was eating lunch outside grocery store and saw stray dog walking around. Employee walked up to dog to try and pet it and the dog bit the person on the right leg and knee. Employee kicked the dog and the dog ran away. Employee reported bite to supervisor immediately. She put ointment and Band-Aids to stop the bleeding. She then went to the local clinic to for a check-up
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	Prior to injury store did not have written policy on dealing with stray animals. Stray animals are now to be reported to animal control and employees are encouraged to stay away from stray animals to prevent future incidents.
