The following DOSH/OSHA Recordable has occurred. In an effort to prevent similar injuries from occurring at your location, please review the injury summary shown below. Remember that a Supervisor's Incident Report is to be completed and faxed to ERNWest, within 24 hours of notification of the incident. Every accident/incident will be investigated regardless of the extent of injuries. Even a near miss or minor injury can give you causes that may stop a more serious accident from occurring in the future. Your experienced based recommendations and ideas for prevention of such an accident are welcomed and **needed**.

I. Injury Summary:

Date Of Injury:	4/23/07
Date Reported:	4/23/07
Injury Type:	Sprained right wrist
Injury Cause:	An employee was wearing Tyvek suit with booties. Employee climbed scaffolding ladder to access work location. As employee got off ladder he slipped on the last metal rung and fell backwards onto the wooden decking injuring his right hand. Employee said he was fine, but his wrist swelled up after lunch. The foreman told the employee he should go to the hospital to make sure it was not broken. Employee went to the hospital and his wrist was x-rayed. X-ray did not show a fracture however, employee was given pain pills to prevent pain and swelling.
Action Taken to Prevent Reoccurrence:	Tyvek booties make walking surfaces very slippery and should not be worn on the scaffolding. We discussed issue with crew and made it mandatory that no-one wears booties while climbing on the scaffolding.
